JOB DESCRIPTION

This position is responsible for leading our Apprentice Programs.. Apprenticeship Programs take place on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays for kids ages 9-11 and focus on nutrition education, soil science and gardening. All curriculum and materials are provided and the programs take place on our farm, next to 520 Hickory Street.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Provide instruction in gardening and nutrition to kids ages 9-11.
- Connecting with kids by being a consistent, positive role model.
- Work alongside kids to assist in farm care such as weeding, pruning, planting and harvesting.
- Provide some care for chickens, goats and ducks.
- Active supervision; respectful, enriching engagement and positive redirection with youth.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Experience with children, especially small groups.
- Experience gardening with vegetables.
- Spanish speaking candidate a plus.
- Strong communication and people skills.
- Organization skills and attention to details.
- Ability to prioritize duties.
